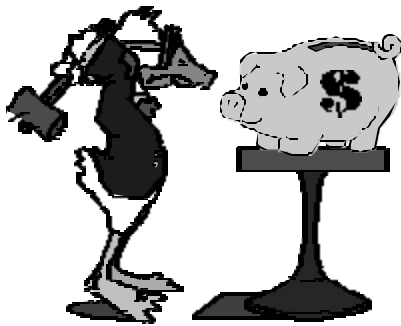

The Color Slide Club of State College

“The Club meets on the third Monday of each month, at 7:30 p.m. in Room 189 Materials Research Lab., Hastings Road, PSU Campus. Competing slides must be in the trays by 7:30, at which time there is a short business meeting followed by the month’s program and the evenings judged competition.

A year’s membership is \$12.00 per individual, \$18.00 per family and \$7.00 per student.

The Color Slide Club of State College, founded in 1947, brings together in its membership a desire to improve, enjoy, and share the art and joy of the photographic image on color slide film.

The Club revolves around a monthly competition in which each active member can enter three slides between two categories, open and special. Special categories vary from month to month and year to year. Judging is done by photographers, visual-arts specialists and artists from the State College area. Points from 1 to 10 are awarded each submitted slide. Those with the highest number of points are awarded first, second, third and honorable mentions. Ribbons and slide film are awarded the winners. The slide club’s year begins in June ending in a slide-of-the-year competition which is made up of all first, second, third and honorable mentions. These slides are sent to be judged by a member of the Photographic Society of America. The winners of the year-end competition are announced and honored at the annual banquet in May. Each April a slide-essay competition is held. Individual members put together a short slide show, six minutes or less, accompanied by music and/ or narration.”

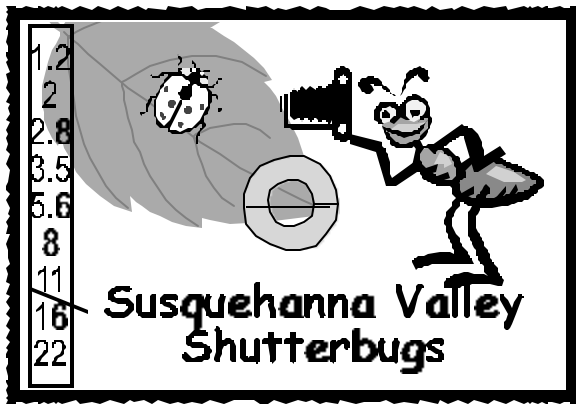
