The program for the April meeting will feature Wayne Palmer, who will speak on various aspects of Digital Photography.

For those of you who don't know, Wayne is the owner-operator of Palmer Multimedia Imaging, a unique business in the Susquehanna Valley devoted to the task of recording and preserving memories. These services include digital photo restoration, film to video transfer, videotape duplication & conversion, DVD conversion, photographic and videographic services – both analog and digital.

Wayne has had a passion for photography all his life. He has a degree in education from Bloomsburg State College, but his interest in photography kept him in the darkroom as much as the classroom. After college, Guardian Photo Inc, employed Wayne for 13 years in the marketing of photo-finishing services on a national level.

Wayne started his own business in 1994, offering custom videographic and photographic services and was the first to offer the Williamsport area on-site digital photo restoration.

His restoration skills have been professionally recognized and he is credited as a contributor to the book **Photoshop Restoration and Retouching**, by Katrin Eismann, released in April 2001.

A self-described AV nerd, Wayne enjoys sharing his knowledge of photography, digital imaging and computers and is a volunteer instructor of computer literacy for the James V. Brown Library.

Among the topics he plans to cover: **Importing Images into your Computer; File Size and Resolution; Scanning; Digital Cameras;** and **The Digital Darkroom for under \$1000**. He will be demonstrating an inexpensive program called **Adobe Photoshop Elements** and will also discuss newly released **Photoshop 7..**

Many of you have expressed an interest in learning more about digital photography. Come out and take advantage of the opportunity to direct your questions to someone who uses the equipment on a daily basis. It should be a fun and informative program.

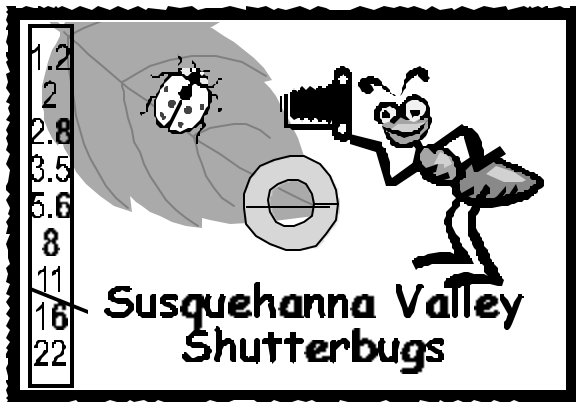
